The Pinnacle Desert

Take a trip up Indian Ocean Drive to the Pinnacles Desert. We will have time to wander around the ancient formations before heading on to the small town of Cervantes for lunch and a factory tour (time permitting) before heading back to Perth.

Busselton Jetty

Spend the day with us as we travel down to Busselton. Once we arrive at the famous Busselton Jetty, we will hop aboard the jetty train, which will take us for a cruise along the jetty. We may be able to catch a glimpse of a dolphin or fisherman out on the ocean while enjoying the full view of Geographe Bay. At the end of the jetty, we will descend down 8 meters below the water to the underwater observatory where we will view the natural wonders of the reef. After lunch, we will head to the Railway museum to learn a little about its history here at Busselton. Now its time to head back to Perth, with perhaps a nap on the way.

Hotham Valley

Upon arrival at Hotham Valley, we will stop for morning tea at the lovely community garden. Northam History

We will start the day with our morning tea down on the river front where we can enjoy the local wildlife and views.
