Private Group Tours - Regional

Pinnacles Desert (PDT2425)

A wonderful day out to experience this unique location north of Perth.

Leaving nice and early, we stop at Seabird for morning tea and a leg stretch. We then head straight to the Pinnacles to see these amazing ancient structures.

Now it's time for lunch! Being so close to Cervantes, we absolutely have to go to Lobster Shack!

Enjoy the fresh seafood menu and an optional tour of the factory*

With full tummies it's time to return to Perth. If time allows we can stop at the Yanchep National Park to see the koalas and kangaroos!

Busselton Day Tour (BDT2425)

One of our favourite regional places to visit is Busselton. It is a truly beautiful place. From here we will ride the train out to the famous Underwater Observatory. (Please note weather conditions can affect this tour). Once we have enjoyed the trip out, we can have lunch at the nearby bistro with wonderful ocean views. Before leaving let's visit a winery! Palmers is just outside of Dunsborough and has some really wonderful wines to try. Now its time to return to Perth after an amazing day out!

New Norcia Day Tour (NNDT2425)

New Norcia was founded in 1847 by the Benedictine Monks. The town has had many purposes over the years including a mission, a monastery and more. The trip starts with a Rove morning tea before heading to the Monastery. Here we will have a guided tour before enjoying a Monks Lunch. There will be time for a wander around the gift shop before making the trip back to Perth, If time allows, lets stop for some Ice Cream!

Wellington Dam and Gnomesville (WDGDT2425)

This is a fun day down south for everyone. We start with morning tea at Gibbs Pool, then it's on our way to Gnomesville. We can have a wander and spot the different Gnomes throughout the garden. Following this, it's on to Collie for lunch at the Federal Hotel. We can then have a wander to spot the trains etc. Finally it is off to see the Dam. Fremantle Maritime Tour FMDT2425
